LANDSCAPE DESIGN

Members of NGC may receive the National Garden Clubs Consultant certificate after attending all lectures in the series, doing the required reading and passing all four course exams with a minimum 70% score within not fewer than two nor more than five years. Courses may be taken in any order and in any state. Those who have passed two courses may join the *Michigan Consultants Council (MCC)*, provided the member's club is affiliated with NGC.

Each course consists of ten (10) hours of lecture (with 11 hours in Course 4), reading assignments and an exam. Exam questions are based 90% on lectures/text, and 10% on a required reading assignment from *The National Gardener*. The exam is optional, to be taken by those wishing to earn a consultant's certificate.

The required text for the four courses is *Stewards of the Land* (code #1316). Students should order this book from Member Services, National Garden Clubs, Inc., by calling 1-314-776-7574 between 9:00am-5:00pm Central Time, by mail at NGC, Inc., 4401 Magnolia Ave., St. Louis, MO 63110-3492, or by Fax at 314-776-5108. Cost is \$40.00 plus shipping. An order form is available on the NGC website www.gardenclubs.org. Allow four (4) weeks for delivery. Required Reading includes chapters 3, 4, 5, 11, 13, 19, 23, 34, 35. Also, an article from *The National Gardener* will be required reading for Course II and will be included in your registration packet provided day one of the course.
