

III- Bylaw Changes—Districts and District Directors

Recommendations to change Bylaws whether re-districting District IIB is approved or not:

Article V: MGC Districts

Reads “MGC is divided into seven (7) Districts. Each District is represented on the MGC Board of Directors by an elected District Director.”

Remove specificity of stating (7).

Change to read: “MGC is divided into Districts defined by the MGC Board of Directors. Each District is represented on the MGC Board of Directors by an elected District Director.”

Article X: Election of Officers

2. Reads “The elected officers of MGC shall be a President, Vice-Presidents, a Recording Secretary, a Treasurer, and seven District Directors (I, IIA, IIB, III, IV, V, VI).”

Remove District IDs in parenthesis after “District Directors”

Change to read: “The elected officers of MGC shall be a President, Vice-Presidents, a Recording Secretary, a Treasurer, and District Directors.”

6. Reads: “If an elected or appointed officer leaves before the end of his or her term, the President may appoint an interim officer with the approval of the Board of Directors for the balance of that officer’s term.”

Provide if we encounter another instance where we could not find an officer to serve after the former officer’s term ended.

6. Change to read: “If an elected or appointed officer leaves before the end of their term, the President may appoint an interim officer with the approval of the Board for the balance of that officer’s term. If unable to find a nominee prior to the upcoming Annual Meeting Election of Officers, the MGC Board will offer a recommendation for approval at the Annual Meeting.”

Discussion:

Recommend this to enable Board flexibility in determining MGC Districts rather than waiting for Annual Meeting. Also give Board to create more districts, as need arises.
