3	Horticulture	Awarded to a garden club that is outstanding in promoting and stressing horticulture by participating in two or more of the following horticultural practices: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Growing plants under artificial light. 2. Pest control avoiding hard pesticides. 3. Placing permanent labels on plant material in areas used by the public. 4. Other-field trip, memorial garden, public workshops. 	State Award for 1st place by club size (S,M,L) \$50.00; 2nd place \$25 by club size.
4	Horticulture	Awarded to a District or club or for outstanding achievement in either of the following: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. An outstanding educational activity to promote good horticultural practice. 2. Overall excellence and a well-balanced program for the year in horticultural activities. 	State Award for 1st place by club size (S,M,L) \$50.00; 2nd place \$25 by club size.
Honorary Award	Liberty Hyde Bailey	Awarded to the garden club which has contributed the most comprehensive offering in any phase of horticulture. May be given to the club applying for one of the above Horticulture awards.	State Award Certificate
6	Landscape Design	Awarded to a garden club which has made the most significant contribution in planning/providing for one of the following <u>completed</u> projects: Examples: commercial property, church, hospital, library, civic center, park, waterfront, other.	State Award for 1st place by club size (S,M,L) \$50.00; 2nd place \$25 by club size.

NOTE: Individual entry photographs and club photographs must not be replicated. Photo entries must differ for each award. Photographer applying for individual award may not be a contributor for the Club award. Entries should be accompanied by a typewritten descriptive commentary keyed to pictures. 7B	Photography (Individual)	Awarded to an individual club member who presents the best set of 5 vertical or horizontal 5"x7" color prints suitable for use by Michigan Gardens Clubs, Inc. on MGC's Website or other promotional uses. Photographer will be credited. Submission of hard copy labeled photographs is required and must differ from photos submitted for 7A.	State Award for 1st place \$25. 2nd Place Certificate.
8A	Native Trees	Award to the garden club that excels in any one of the following: 1. Promotion of the planting and care of Native Trees. Tree must be named and type of care described. 2. Development of a Native Tree Educational program for garden club meetings. 3. Involvement of youth (school children, teens, 4-H Clubs, Scouts etc.) to encourage the planting and maintenance of Native Trees.	State Award for 1st place by club size (S,M,L) \$50.00; 2nd place \$25 by club size.
8B	Arbor Day	Awarded to the garden club for the best overall promotion of Arbor Day. Emphasis on the importance of planting, replenishing, and environmental impact of trees and to heighten community awareness through educational programs, new plantings, and projects.	State Award 1st place by club size (S,M,L) \$50.00; 2nd place \$25.00 by club size
8C	Arbor Day Youth Activity	Awarded to the garden club for the best overall promotion of Arbor Day involving youth. Emphasis on teaching youth the importance of the environmental impact that trees have within the community and worldwide. 10	Educational Publications Club (Printed or Electronic)	Awarded to a garden club, or group of clubs providing the most outstanding 4 consecutive weeks or months of high caliber educational articles on various aspects of gardening published in print or on social media for their club or District. 1. must reference MGC within the publication; 2. must have 2 or more members participating in writing articles. Dated copies of articles must accompany award application.	State Award for 1st place by club size (S,M,L) \$50.00; 2nd place \$25 by club size.
11	Educational Publications Individual (Printed or Electronic)	Awarded for the best feature article written by a garden club member highlighting subject areas of horticulture, gardening, landscape or floral design, or the environment. Published article should be approximately 1000 words and have appeared in a newspaper, periodical, or community publication. Dated article must accompany application.	State Award for 1st place by club size (S,M,L) \$50.00; 2nd place \$25 by club size.
12	Senior Outreach	Awarded to a garden club that provides garden therapy activities for seniors or coordinates with another organization to provide community outreach to seniors in the area of horticulture/ design or environment. Examples: Planting raised bed gardens, teaching table gardening, making/distributing cups of cheer with/to a senior facility.	State Award for 1st place by club size (S,M,L) \$50.00; 2nd place \$25 by club size.
13	Horticulture Display	Awarded to a garden club for a display of Horticulture and/or Design using live or dried material in a public building such as a library, art center, museum, city hall, etc. New display to be placed quarterly throughout the current year. Signage used should acknowledge the club as well as MGC. Include photos with captions.	State Award for 1st place by club size (S,M,L) \$50.00; 2nd place \$25 by club size.

15A	Share The Harvest Community Vegetable Garden	Awarded to the garden club that works with local residents within the community by educating, planting, and harvesting vegetable/herb gardens. The residents are required to participate with club members in the gardening project.	State Award for 1st place by club size (S,M,L) \$50.00; 2nd place \$25 by club size. <i>(Award initiated by former MGC President, Nancy Stark)</i>
15B	Share The Harvest Vegetables in Flower Beds	Awarded to a garden club that incorporates vegetable and herbs into established flower gardens to educate the public and then harvest the produce for donation to local food kitchens and community food organizations. 15C	Share The Harvest Youth	Awarded to a garden club that plants vegetables and herbs in containers and/or raised beds where participants can grow and harvest the food. Special consideration should be given to educating children in growing vegetables in containers.	State Award for 1st place by club size (S,M,L) \$50.00; 2nd place \$25 by club size. <i>(Award initiated by former MGC President, Nancy Stark)</i>
16A	Holiday Decor	Awarded to a club for an outstanding effort to beautify the community with holiday decor using greenery/swags/pots containing live or dried items with a theme that furthers MGC's goals and objectives. Photos required.	State Award for 1st place by club size (S,M,L) \$50.00; 2nd place \$25 by club size.
16B	Holiday Decor Youth	Awarded to a garden club for the best holiday tree decorations created by youth using live, dried, and/or recycled materials following a theme that furthers MGC goals and objectives and is displayed in public for community awareness. 21	Membership Promotion	Awarded to a garden club with the most innovative activity, set of activities, or the most outstanding effort to increase public visibility for the purpose of increasing club membership or to make the public aware of the mission and activities of garden clubs. Examples include, membership brochures, leaflets, other club publications, or publicity the club has received. Printed materials must be included and submitted with the application.
